If you have moved into the County or changed addresses within the County, you can fill out a registration application by going to <https://www.sos.state.mn.us/elections-voting/register-to-vote> or call 507-637-4013 to obtain an application.

Pre-registration closes, Tuesday, July 21st at 5 p.m. for the Primary Election and is highly recommended to reduce time registering on Election Day.

Absentee voting began Friday, June 26, 2020 and ends Monday, August 10, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

- Applications and voting can be done at the Redwood County Auditor/Treasurer's Office, 403 S. Mill St., Redwood Falls, M-F 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. and Saturday, August 8, 2020 from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Online or paper absentee applications can be obtained by going to <https://www.sos.state.mn.us/elections-voting/other-ways-to-vote/>. All absentee ballots must be hand delivered to this office by the voter themselves or an agent for the voter by 3:00 p.m. on Election Day or must be post-marked **on or before** Election Day, using U.S. mail or a package delivery service and received by the County by the day before the county canvass, which may take place on the second or third day following the election for your ballot to be counted.

If you have not pre-registered, you will need to register on Election Day at the Polling Location.

- Go to <https://www.sos.state.mn.us/elections-voting/register-to-vote/register-on-election-day/> and find “**Acceptable Proof of Residence**” to bring along to the Polling Location or call 507-637-4013.

Poll pads have replaced paper rosters and are being used in all but three precincts on Election Day. To make lines move faster, voters are encouraged (*not required*) to bring along their current Driver's License for the Election Judge to scan.
