
. U.S. POSTAL SERVICE GUIDELINES FOR LATERAL PLACEMENT OF MAILBOXES



MAIL BOX POLICY or PROPERTY IN BOULEVARD vs. SNOW REMOVAL

The City of Redwood Falls shall conduct snow removal activities in such a fashion as to minimize damage to private property, in, or adjacent to, the boulevards of all public rights-of-way. In the event damage does occur, the City will accept responsibility subject to the following provisions:

- 1. Damage to curb and gutter obstructions shall not be repaired at the City's expense.
- 2. Mailboxes located in the boulevard pursuant to the policies of the U. S. Postal Service, which are damaged to the extent that they are rendered unusable, shall qualify for up to \$25 in reimbursement with appropriate, submitted documentation. Damage must have occurred as a result of physical contact by the snow plow hitting the mailbox and not by snow hitting the box.
- 3. Any other immobile property or structure located in the boulevard, which is damaged, is not eligible for City reimbursement unless said damage is the result of <u>physical contact between a snowplow</u> and the property or structure.
- 4. The City will provide no compensation for damage to immobile property or structures located temporarily in the boulevard, unless said damage is the result of <u>physical contact between a snowplow</u> and the property or structure.
