SUBJECT: #6 LIGHTING EXEMPTION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLES

## I. POLICY

It is the policy of the Redwood Falls Police Department to provide a uniform guideline for all department personnel to use when operating a department vehicle without headlights, taillights while functioning as a peace officer.

## II. PROCEDURE

#### A. Definitions

- 1. <u>Vehicle</u>: A motor vehicle or watercraft owned, leased or otherwise the property of the State of Minnesota or a political subdivision.
- 2. <u>Lights</u>: Headlights and taillights as referenced in MN Stat. 84.87 to 84.928, 169.48 to 169.65 and 86B.511.

### B. Procedure

A peace officer may **not** operate a vehicle without lights contrary to MN STAT 169.541. LIGHTING EXEMPTION FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT; STANDARDS under conditions of limited or reduced visibility as defined in MN STAT 84.87, 84.928, 169.48 to 169.65 and 86B.511:

- On an interstate highway.
- 2. At speeds greater than what is reasonable and prudent under existing weather, road and traffic conditions.
- Faster than the posted speed limit.
- 4. In situations where the peace officer is an active participant in the pursuit of a motor vehicle in violation of MN STAT 609.487.
