WATER SERVICE LINE INVENTORY





The City of Redwood Falls is working to complete an inventory of all water service lines within the system. We are asking residents to help with the process and perform a water service pipe material survey. The EPA is requiring this survey of all cities nationwide and is scheduled to be completed by May 31, 2024.

You can identify your pipe material by checking your household water service connections inside your home, typically located in your basement. Use the guide below to determine your water pipe material.

Once you determine your pipe material, <u>complete the on-line survey by scanning the QR code</u>. If you need assistance, please call City Hall at 507-616-7400.

LEAD

A dull, silver-gray color that is easily scratched with a coin. Use a magnet to detect the material – strong magnets will <u>not</u> cling to lead pipes.

GALVANIZED

A dull, silver-gray color. Use a magnet to detect the material – strong magnets will typically cling to galvanized pipes.

PLASTIC

Blue or black pipe.

COPPER

The color of a penny.
