

Park Commission Announces “Adopt-A-Tree” Program

The Redwood Falls Park and Recreation Commission is pleased to announce the creation of an Adopt-A-Tree Program. The Adopt-A-Tree Program provides individuals, businesses and organizations with the opportunity to beautify the Redwood Falls' park system by donating trees that will be planted in local parks.

The Adopt-A-Tree Program is a unique way to provide recognition to honor an individual or celebrate a special occasion. Trees can be donated to commemorate a birthday, marriage, or anniversary. The Adopt-A-Tree Program can also provide a living memorial for a departed friend or loved one. Civic organizations may feel compelled to donate a tree for the beautification of the park system, while businesses may wish to donate a tree as a tribute to an outstanding long-term employee or retiree.

The Adopt-A-Tree Program is requesting donations in the amounts of \$150 and \$300. A donation of \$150 will purchase a 1"- 1¼" caliper tree; a donation of \$300 will purchase a 1½" - 2" caliper tree. Donors may select the location and type of tree to be planted from a list of pre-determined sites and varieties. Please contact City Hall for sites and varieties that are currently available.
