

## REDWOOD FALLS DEER HUNT REGULATIONS

- Discharge of bows is limited to designated hunting sites and is only allowed from elevated stands or other defined by Hunt Coordinator. A person is required to travel to and from hunting sites with bows and arrows encased / covered.
- Portable tree stands that are bolted, clamped or tied are allowed. A person may NOT use screw-in type tree steps.
- All stands should be labeled with owner's full name and contact information.
- All stands must be removed within one week of season end or the stand will be forfeited and a \$100 fine issued.
- Trimming of trees is prohibited unless approved by Archery Hunt Coordinator.
- Trail cameras are prohibited.
- Driving or stalking deer on the ground is prohibited. All hunters will shoot deer from stand, and only shoot out to 20 yards. In no event shall a hunter discharge a bow from anywhere other than a designated tree stand without authorization.
- In the event a hunter wounds a deer the hunter shall pursue deer on foot with bow encased to attempt to locate the animal. The following procedure shall be used:
  - In the case of a fatally wounded deer that is still alive, the hunter will be required to contact the City of Redwood Falls Archery Hunt Coordinator before proceeding further if wounded animal is off of City Property. The hunter will provide the Coordinator with the last known location and make arrangements to meet. The hunter will lead the Coordinator to the injured animal and a decision will be made on appropriate recovery methods. In no event shall a hunter discharge a bow from anywhere other than a designated tree stand without authorization.
- Entrails ("gut") piles must be removed from the recovery site.
- Hunters in Ramsey Park may park their vehicle within the park and walk to their hunting stand. A vehicle permit is required. Bows and arrows must remain encased except while in the tree stand. Soft cases, and bow sling cases are acceptable.
- All park regulations and MN DNR regulations are in force unless specifically exempted.
- Do not trespass onto other land other than City of Redwood Falls. Ask for written permission before passing onto land other than the City of Redwood Falls.
